



## COVID UPDATE FOR JUMPERS AND JAZZ IN JULY 2021

To ensure our Festival meets all Covid regulations, the Management Committee has put together an efficient system which should make for easy access through designated entry points.

### **N.B.**

" Keeping everyone safe is a priority at our Festival. We request that everyone bring your masks with you (there may be a last minute "change of rules!"). For visitors who may be arriving from areas even close to current hot spots or if you are coming through borders, then please be sure to wear your mask at the festival and adhere to all current Qld Government restrictions and guidelines.

If you currently reside in a hot spot zone at the time of the festival, are unwell or vulnerable in health, then we **MUST** ask you to please stay at home. We want everyone to **STAY SAFE** as much as possible.

### **Every Day Entry to Festival**

We are asking for your patience as we continue to navigate this covid safe journey. In the past visitors have had the pleasure of being able to freely wander our streets, enjoying the street vibe without constraints. This year will be a little different, but you will still be able to fully embrace the street vibe and the energy of the festival.

A map with designated entry/exit points will be published for your viewing before the festival commences, along with suggested parking venues.

This will be available as a link through our website and Facebook page.

The QR code will be in place at these designated points and our friendly volunteers will be on hand to assist with all check-ins.

Visitors will be issued with a coloured JJJ wristband once they have checked in. This is the simplest way for us to confirm that check-in has occurred. Our cheery "Covid-Ambassadors" will be roaming around throughout the day and assisting where required to ensure all festival goers have indeed successfully checked in.

This process will need to happen every day. New wrist bands will be issued.

We are committed to processes that protect everyone and ensures our festival remains a covid safe event ...whilst maintaining the vibrancy and quirkiness we all expect to enjoy when attending the Jumpers and Jazz in July festival.
